2. Course selection should be entered online using the Course Selection Module in the Parent Portal of PowerSchool (course selection is not available through the Student Portals). Selections entered through the Parent Portal are considered to have parent approval. Any issues concerning the portal access should be directed to Mr. Olson.
3. Because course selection at this level has broader post-secondary implications, students and parents are asked to consult with our Academic Counsellors, teachers or our Heads of Departments (HODs) should they have any questions.
4. The deadline for course selections to be entered into PowerSchool is **March 7, 2019.**
5. **Note:** Students seeking admission into enriched and/or accelerated courses and programs in the Mathematics and Social Studies must have their applications approved by the respective Head of Department. Applications and an explanation of the various steps involved are on our [STMC Grades 8-12 Academics](#) link on our school website. See Head of Departments (HODs) for details.
6. Students interested in the *Combined Pre-Calculus 12/Calculus 12* class should speak to the Head of Department. This course requires two blocks on the timetable. Selecting the course does not guarantee entry to the course. Final placement will be made by the HOD in consultation with current mathematics teachers.
7. Many of our senior courses have prerequisites – please see the course descriptors for details.
8. Courses with “\*” are Outside of Timetable. (See Mr. Shoemaker for details – admission for some courses is by audition.)
