Easing the stress!

The process can be quite daunting for parents and, of course for your sons and daughters. While you may be new to the process, we are not. Trust the process.

- Unless there are very unusual circumstances, all our students graduate.
- We meet with all our grade 12's in <u>Career Life Connections class</u> biweekly and give them related tasks.
 (Application and scholarship tips and deadlines.)
- Mr. Bouwman will reach out to students through **Religion 12 and CLC.** This gives opportunities to connect and help students with their plans.

In addition, our teachers are excellent and will help prepare and support your sons and daughters as well!

The Career Life and Post-Secondary Information Google Classrooms

Your sons and daughters are signed up on two important sites.

The **Post Secondary information site** informs the students about upcoming university/college events and scholarship opportunities. The **Career Life site** includes all the assignments related to Career Life

12. This is a mandatory course that all students must complete to graduate from BC.

Universities do not count the mark in their admissions process but this mark appears on their transcript so schools and scholarship committees can see the mark. Your sons or daughter can invite you to see these sites.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS SIMPLIFIED



Students and parents are in the **shopping mode** at this point.

All schools are offering info sessions over the next few months.

Admission is based on GPA **and** personal profile questions, not your date of application. You do not need grade 12 marks to apply.

When applying, schools simply want your demographic info, your intended major and your money.

Choosing intended majors can be strategic and involve some planning. Schools will ask you to **choose two** faculties or programs.



REMEMBER WHEN STUDENTS CHOOSE A FACULTY, THEY ARE NOT LOCKED IN FOR LIFE!

Up to 70% of students will change their major at the post-secondary level.

There is **no real advantage to applying to a large number of schools.** Narrow down the **legitimate options** and always have a fail-safe back up plan! **2-4 schools is MORE than enough**.

There is a *needless* trend to apply to numerous schools (Over 10).

Attend info sessions (either virtual or in person), visit us and do your research

Parents and students get anxious because the applications sites for most schools are already open but really **you do not have to rush**.

Your job is to trust the process and encourage your sons and daughters to be proactive.

Students sweat over every mark and test. Encourage them to do their best on a consistent basis and things will work out!

This is a stressful time for them and they may need an extra dose of your love and support.

MARKS AND GPA AVERAGES

IT IS EASY TO TELL STUDENTS AND PARENTS TO NOT WORRY ABOUT MARKS BUT OF COURSE
THEY PANIC. THEY JUST HAVE TO DO THEIR BEST.

Honestly, UBC is not for everyone and **NO AMOUNT OF STRESS WILL IMPROVE YOUR GPA.** It is all about working hard and finding YOUR best fit. There are a lot of options.

The best strategy is for students to consistently work hard right from the start.

Grade 11 marks DO play a role in early admission decisions.

SCHOOLS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO SEE A STUDENT'S GRADE 12 GRADES UNTIL EARLY DECEMBER.

THE MOST IMPORTANT GRADES ARE THE ONES REPORTED AT THE END OF THEIR SECOND TERM.



Local Colleges have deadlines that extend well into the next year. Cap, Kwantlen and Langara offer earlier course selection based on application dates. **Non-BC Canadian Schools** have application dates that go from mid-December on. For Ontario schools it is a good idea to apply by Christmas but the deadline is later. January 15th.


USA Schools have a variety of application dates: Students should apply early before Christmas of by mid January at the latest. SATs are required in many cases and students must register to write this test through the College Board. The US application process is complex and it is important for the students to be proactive.
